He held numerous prestigious qualifications including M.B.B.S. (Punjab), F.C.P.S., F.R.C.P. (Ireland), MPH (London), D.C.H. (Ireland), and D.T.M. & H. (London).

Dr. Wasti served as Professor Emeritus of Paediatrics at King Edward Medical College, Lahore, and was also a Founder Fellow and Professor Emeritus at the College of Physicians and Surgeons, Karachi. Through his vision and dedication, the Trust has been serving communities in the fields of health and education for decades.



(1ST PHASE)

## INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REPORT TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES

### Report on the Audit of the Financial Statements

#### Opinion




